



Womens 6's at Saxton

All matches shall be played in accordance with:

- (a) The playing conditions as specified in this section,
- (b) Nelson Cricket Association General Playing Conditions
- (c) The conditions specified in the Laws of Cricket (2017 Code 3rd Edition 2022) of the Marylebone Cricket Club. www.lords.org/mcc/the-laws-of-cricket

And to the extent that there is a conflict between those conditions, the conditions shall be applied in the order of priority set out above to the intent that the playing conditions in subparagraph (a) will be of the highest priority and the Laws of Cricket in subparagraph (c) will be of the least priority. In addition, all players, clubs and umpires shall comply with the by-laws of the NCA in force from time to time

Womens 6's at Saxton will be played, except as provided below.

- Games are played at Saxton Oval on Mondays commencing at 6.30pm
- If due to weather conditions either side is unable to be completed, the game shall be abandoned, and two points awarded.
- Each team shall consist of **6 players**
- **12 Overs** to be bowled per side
- Bowling will take place in **2 x 6-over chunks**. i.e. 6 overs bowled from 1 end and 6 overs bowled from the other end.
- All Bowlers must bowl 2 overs per match
- Batters will bat in pairs for four overs
- A wicket will add 5 runs to the bowling teams score
- Bowling run ups **shall not exceed 5 meters**.
- Wides and no balls shall be counted as **2 runs** and added to the batting team's total. The first two Wides and No balls are to be rebowled, but only to a maximum of 8 balls in the over, unless in the last over of the innings.

- The grade of ball to be used in all matches shall be a Kookaburra Senior Supasoft Incredaball. NCA to provide the ball
- No Leg Before Wicket (LBW) decisions will be given unless you don't play a shot – (If the ball was going to continue and hit the stumps it can be given out)
- There are no Free Hits
- There are no restrictions on fielding positions. No fielder, apart from the wicketkeeper, is to be within 10 meters of the batter.
- Teams must provide their own umpires (2) while they bat.
- Shoes must be always worn.
- Teams to provide their own wooden bats if possible
- It is preferred if you wear some form of batting glove, to stop the bat from slipping out of your hands if you start to perspire. (they are for others protection more than yours)
- Games will be scored on paper sheets. An NCA employee will be there to assist with any questions around this. – NCA to provide the sheets
- In common with all other clubs and teams coming under the jurisdiction of the NCA, players are required to abide by the rules governing acceptable conduct on and off the field of play.

Cancellations will be advertised on the Nelson Cricket Facebook Page and team captains will be contacted at least an hour prior to start time.
